

MONEY MATTERS

YOU DON'T PAY TUITION FEES IF YOU'RE A UK OR EU STUDENT AGED UNDER 19 WHEN YOU START YOUR PROGRAMME. HOWEVER, YOU MAY HAVE TO PAY FOR SOME EQUIPMENT AND RESOURCES OR NEED SOME FINANCIAL SUPPORT DURING YOUR STUDIES. THERE ARE VARIOUS FINANCIAL SCHEMES AVAILABLE AND WE'RE PASSIONATE ABOUT MAKING SURE YOU GET THE FUNDING YOU'RE ENTITLED TO.

TUITION FEES

- Aged under 19 no tuition fees
- Aged 19+ you'll pay the full tuition fee, subsidised tuition fee or may be eligible for a Learner Loan depending on your circumstances
- Apprenticeshipsyour employer will pay the fee
- Work experience/placement no fees to pay.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FUND

Supports the cost of things like a uniform, equipment or transport if your parents have a combined household income of less than £25,000 per year.

£1,200 BURSARY

You'll receive this if you're aged 16-19 and either in care, a care leaver, receive Income Support/Universal Credit or are a disabled learner receiving ESA (Employment Support Allowance) or Universal Credit AND Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payments in your own right.

FREE COLLEGE MEALS

Financial support is available for eligible students. If you have free meals at school, you'll normally receive them at college too.

CARE TO LEARN SCHEME

This provides funding to students aged under 20 who need assistance with childcare costs and meet certain criteria.

CHILDCARE

We've a list of registered childcare providers who can provide support. If you're aged 20+ and receive a means tested benefit, we may also contribute towards your childcare costs.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

If you're aged 19+ and want to study a Level 3 programme or higher (subject to eligibility) this Government loan contributes towards fees. Certain eligibility criteria apply and repayments start the April after you complete or withdraw from your programme.

You'll start to pay back your loan (plus interest) when you earn £25,000 or more a year. Your annual repayment will be 9% of any income you earn over £25,000.

- £37 a month earning £30,000pa

AN APPRENTICESHIP IS FOR YOU IF YOU WANT TO GET A JOB, EARN A SALARY, GET REAL LIFE INDUSTRY EXPERIENCE AND STUDY AT COLLEGE USUALLY ONE DAY EVERY WEEK. WORKING AT A LOCAL EMPLOYER BETWEEN ONE TO FOUR YEARS, YOU'LL DEVELOP NEW SKILLS, GROW YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND GAIN A RECOGNISED INDUSTRY QUALIFICATION, SO YOU'RE READY TO PROGRESS YOUR CAREER OR MOVE INTO HIGHER FDUCATION.

WHAT DOES AN APPRENTICESHIP INVOLVE?

Learning-on-the-job

Spending most of your time with your employer, you'll gain hands-on experience, earn a salary and pick up the skills, knowledge and behaviours you need to succeed.

College study

You'll spend 20% of your apprenticeship doing off-the-job training.

Maths & English

You'll develop your maths and English skills, aligning them to your job.

Endpoint assessment

Your employer and mentor will 'signoff' your apprentice as being ready for assessment towards the end of your apprenticeship.



WHO CAN APPLY FOR AN APPRENTICESHIP?

- Aged 16 years or older
- A qualification in maths and English (our Apprenticeship team can discuss this with you in more detail)
- Not in full-time education
- Living in England

HOW CAN YOU PROGRESS YOUR CAREER?

When you complete your apprenticeship at college, you can progress into employment full-time or go on to study a Higher or Degree Level Apprenticeship. These provide you with more advanced skills and qualifications, so you can go into management or a specialist role, such as a nurse, teacher, police officer or legal executive. They are a great way to gain a university level qualification without paying tuition fees.

We'll support your skill development if you haven't achieved GCSE grades 9/A* - 4/C or a Level 2 Functional Skills qualification if you're aged 19+.

- Aged 16-24
- Not in a current job
- Little work experience.

While the work placement part of a traineeship is unpaid, you'll be able to access financial support schemes if eligible.
