For the Advanced learner Loan Bursary, you will need to provide evidence that your Household income is below £35,000.00 per annum.

The evidence you will need to supply will depend on your living arrangements and age.

Parent(s)	18+ years or over	Your (the students) financial information
Guardian(s)	18 years or over	Your (the students) financial information
With a Partner	16 years or over	Your <b>joint</b> financial information
Independently (includes shared accommodation)	16 years or over	Your (the students) financial information
