Vocational / Subject Area Qualification

This is the subject you have chosen to study and makes up most of the time for your Study Programme.

Your classes are a mix of theory and practical and will help you develop the skills and knowledge you need to progress in your chosen career.

Digital Skills

Digital skills are essential in the workplace. During your self-directed study time you will work through a series of Digital Skills modules to make sure you are confident and competent in your skills.

Digital Skills are also embedded throughout your Study Programme.

Tracking and Monitoring

You will have a weekly “Tracking and Monitoring” session with your tutor, to help you keep on top of your work and record your progress.

You will have the opportunity to set and review targets, so you stay focussed on your studies and progress towards your career goals.

Maths and English

Maths and English skills are vital in the workplace. So you will continue to develop your maths and English skills at college. You will complete a skills assessment to identify the areas you need to work on. You will be given project work to help you develop your skills further.

If you don't already have Grade 4 in Maths and / or English, you will continue to study towards these qualifications.

Enrichment
